## Promoting the Reading Program

- Explain Reading Program procedures to interested individuals and enroll them in the program.
- Use the action suggestions listed in this catalog as a guide for choosing titles and mission responses.
- Secure books and circulate them among unit and circle members.
- Distribute copies of this catalog.

- Distribute copies of the Reading Program Report Form so participants can keep track of and report their reading. The Report Form is available for shipping and handling or as a free download at [unitedmethodistwomen.org/downloads](https://unitedmethodistwomen.org/downloads)

The Bible undergirds all Christian reading, including that of the Reading Program. The magazine *response*, essential reading for understanding the mission of United Methodist Women, is part of all four reading plans.

## Local and District Groups

- Form an action team to address issues discussed in one or more books.
- Start a reading group for adults, children or youth. Meet regularly to share and discuss the books members are reading.
- Present book reviews at United Methodist Women group meetings.
- Take Reading Program books and *response* to retirement and nursing homes. Read regularly to residents.
- Inform parents, grandparents and Sunday school teachers that books for children and youth are available through the Reading Program.
- Highlight large print books and book listings available for the visually impaired.
- Honor those who participate in the Reading Program. Download Reading Program certificates from [unitedmethodistwomen.org/downloads](https://unitedmethodistwomen.org/downloads) to present to those who complete reading plans.
- Display progress charts in a prominent place, showing readers' names, books read and reading plans being followed.
- Capture interest by attractively mounting quotations from Reading Program books and posting them throughout your church. Include title, author name, publisher and year title was featured on the Reading Program list.
- Develop displays, both permanent and portable, to encourage book sales, especially around holiday seasons and vacation times.

# The Reading Program Leads to Action!

For 150 years, members of United Methodist Women and predecessor organizations have been involved in mission that includes prayer, study and action. The Reading Program is a study opportunity, but it should also lead to action. Here are a few suggestions to assist you:

## ACTION SUGGESTIONS

**Pray.** Books often raise concerns about people, countries and issues. Bring these concerns to God during your prayer time at home and at group meetings. Pray for those concerns. Read *Spoken into Being* and think about creating and telling your story.

**Host a program.** Read “*We Are All Fast-Food Workers Now*” and continue the discussion on economic injustice around the world.

**Teach a Sunday school class.** Read titles from

the children’s list with a Sunday school class. Read *No One Else Like You* and celebrate diversity and tolerance. Read *Red* and continue your discussion around bullying.

**Be inclusive.** Continue your action on the Charter for Racial Justice Policies of The United Methodist Church. Read *Where Do We Go from Here: Chaos or Community?*.

God bless you as you pray, study, act and organize in Christ’s name.

## B Bonus Books

## 개체 및 지방 여성교회

- 부모들, 조부모들, 그리고 주일학교 교사들에게 독서 프로그램의 아동 및 청소년 권장 도서에 대해 알린다.
- 큰 활자체로 된 도서들과 시각장애자용 도서들이 있다는 점을 강조한다.
- 독서 프로그램 참여자들을 특별히 대우한다. [unitedmethodistwomen.org/downloads](http://unitedmethodistwomen.org/downloads) 에서 독서프로그램 수료증을 구입해, 독서계획안을 마친 회원들에게 수여한다.
- 프로그램 참여자들의 이름, 읽고 있는 책, 앞으로 읽을 책 등을 한눈에 볼 수 있는 도표를 만들어 눈에 띄는 곳에 전시한다.
- 독서 프로그램의 권장 도서에서 몇 구절을 적어 보기 좋게 장식한 뒤, 교회 곳곳에 붙여 사람들이 관심을 갖도록 한다. 이때, 책 제목, 저자, 출판사, 출판연도 등 인용 구절의 원작에 대한 정보와 함께 연합감리교회 여성교회 독서프로그램의 권장 도서임을 밝힌다.
- 특히 명절과 휴가철을 전후해서, 도서 판매 및 구매를 장려하는 전시용 도서 보관함과 이동용 탁자를 준비하여 권장 도서들을 전시한다.

# 독서 프로그램은 행동으로 이끈다!

연합감리교회 여선교회와 전신 기관들의 회원들은 150년 동안 기도와, 공부와 행동으로 선교에 참여해왔다. 독서 프로그램은 공부할 좋은 기회이다. 독서 프로그램은 또한 공부뿐만 아니라 행동으로 옮길 수 있도록 이끌어 주기도 한다. 여러분이 책을 읽고 난 뒤, 읽은 내용을 행동으로 옮기고 싶다면 다음과 같은 일을 해보기 바란다.

## 행동을 위한 제안

**기도한다.** 권장 도서들은 다른 민족이나 다른 나라에 대해서, 그리고 여러 가지 당면 문제들에 관해서 관심을 불러일으키게 해준다. 집에서나 여선교회의 크고 작은 모임에서 기도할 때 이런 관심사를 하나님께 고한다. *세상을 위한 기도를 위한 내부 지침서*를 읽는다.

**프로그램을 주최한다.** *우리 모두는 이제 즉석식품을 만드는 이들*(“We are All Fast-Food Workers Now”)을 읽고 경제 불평등에 관해 토론하라.

**주일학교에서 가르친다.** 주일 학교에서 어린이들의 도서 목록에 나오는 책들을 읽는다. *나는 독특한 존재이다*(Nobody

*Else Like You*)를 읽고 다양성을 축복하라. *붉음*(Red)을 읽고 왕따에 관해서 토론한다.

**포용적인 사람이 된다.** 연합감리교회의 인종정의정책 헌장 (Charter for Racial Policies of the United Methodist Church)을 꾸준히 실천에 옮긴다. *이제 무엇을 할 것인가*(Where Do We Go From Here)를 읽는다.
